Exercise Plan for the Dogs of Dog Sled Rides of Winter Park

In order to comply with PACFA rule 12.00 B.1.c(2), the below written plan of exercise and conditioning is in force at Dog Sled Rides of Winter Park. All staff members have been instructed as to the importance of keeping to this plan and the importance of maintaining the required, voluminous records.

Definitions

- 1. Cart trip: A trip in which the dogs are tethered to a four-wheeled cart that they pull that rolls that may or may not have additional weight in the cart in the form of paying customers, non-paying customers, miscellaneous cargo or simulated weight in the form of friction caused by a dragging weight. There may be eight to sixteen dogs tethered to each cart. Cart trips may last from twenty minutes to one hour with the majority of trips being forty-five minutes with paying customers. During each trip, there are planned and unplanned stops to rest the dogs, take pictures, observe or avoid wildlife, deal with obstacles on the trail and water the dogs. The actual time that the dogs are pulling is approximately eighty percent of the total trip time.
- 2. Dog yard: A one and a half acre fenced area in which the dogs live, tethered near their individual houses.
- 3. Exercise group: A group of dogs that exercises together. Dogs are divided into groups based on the sex and energy levels of the dogs. The goal is to create harmonious groups where each of the dogs in the group feels comfortable in the group.
- 4. Exercise yard: A three acre fenced area adjacent to the dog yard. The yard is mostly wooded with a few grassy areas.
- 5. Scooter trip: A trip in which the dogs are tethered to a two-wheeled scooter that they pull that rolls that has one driver on the scooter. There may be one to three dogs tethered to each scooter. Scooter trips may last from ten minutes to one hour with the majority of trips being twenty-five minutes with a staff member driving.. During each trip, there are planned and unplanned stops to rest the dogs, observe or avoid wildlife, deal with obstacles on the trail and water the dogs. The actual time that the dogs are pulling is approximately eighty percent of the total trip time.
- 6. Services: Each of the different trips is considered to be a service.
- 7. Sled trip: A trip in which the dogs are tethered to a sled that they pull that slides that may or may not have additional weight in the sled in the form of paying customers, non-paying customers, miscellaneous cargo or simulated weight in the form of friction caused by a dragging weight. There may be six to twelve dogs tethered to each sled. Sled trips may last from twenty minutes to one hour with the majority of trips being forty-five minutes with paying customers. During each trip, there are planned and unplanned stops to rest the dogs, take pictures, observe or avoid wildlife, or deal with obstacles on the trail. The actual time that the dogs are pulling is approximately eighty percent of the total trip time.

Primary Exercise Plan

The primary exercise plan is in effect when the demand for our services is high. The demand for services fluctuates depending on the general global economy (especially the unemployment, savings and inflation rates of the United States), the local weather, and the time of year.

Each dog is scheduled to run an appropriate number of trips per day based on their ability level. The minimum number of trips per day is zero. The maximum number of sled trips is three per day, six days per week. The maximum number of cart trips is one per day, seven days per week. The maximum number of scooter trips is one per day, seven days per week. The actual number of trips that each dog runs depends primarily on the demand for each of these services. In practice, each dog runs about seventy-five percent of their individual

assigned maximum levels.

Secondary Exercise Plan

When demand for our services is low, and the dogs are running less than twenty-five percent of their individual maximum levels, the secondary exercise plan goes into effect.

Each dog is assigned to an exercise group. The current exercise groups can be found at any time on our website at www.dogsledrides.com/wintepark/dogs.php. During the time in which the secondary exercise plan is in effect, zero to four different exercise groups are rotated from their houses into the exercise yard each day. Each group remains in the exercise yard between one and eight hours with the average being one and a half hours. There are no actual exercise requirements from the dogs, and they are left to decide for themselves what level of activity they choose to exert during their time in the yard. On average, the dogs spend eighty percent of their time in the yard sniffing and peeing.

Additional Exercise Plan

When the dogs are not participating in the primary or secondary exercise plans, they each have access to 113 square feet of space. They are allowed to walk, trot, run or sleep for as many hours per day (up to twenty-four) as they wish in this space.

Average Annual Calendar

Our schedule throughout the year varies with the weather. On average, our year looks like this:

January through mid April: We run sled trips with paying customers five to seven days per week.

Mid April to mid May: The dogs are rotated in and out of the exercise yard.

Mid May to mid November: We run scooters and carts, and rotate the dogs in and out of the exercise yard.

Mid November to second week of December: We run carts, scooters and sleds, depending on weather, with customers or without customers and a drag attached.

The rest of December: We run sleds six days per week.
